- 1. A: 999.
- 2. B: 999, we are now in
- 3. A: What happened?
- 4. C: Hello.
- 5. A: What happened?
- 6. C: Er, we are staff members of Hong Kong Electric. Right after leaving the power plant on Lamma Island not long ago, (I) suddenly heard a 'Bang' (transliteration). The board overhead my seat collapsed. Now, all the light went off. (I) heard people saying (someone is) bleeding. I believe (we) are at the sea near Lamma Island.

- 7. A: Sorry, what have collapsed?
- 8. C: All the boards overhead my (seat) on the vessel collapsed.
- 9. A: Right, is anyone got trapped?
- 10. C: ER, not sure.
- 11. A: Could you please hold, I put (the call) through to the Ambulance Console. Don't hang up. You are now on the vessel, right (homonym)?
- 12. C: On-board the vessel, on-board our Hong Kong Electric vessel.
- 13. A: What's your surname?

14. C: My surname is LAW (transliteration).

15. A: Could you tell the situation?

16. C: We just left the power plant not long ago because (I) just got up (and) looked out from the window, (I) believe (we) are off Lamma Island.

17. D: I want to know your, where your location is.

18. C: At sea off Lamma Island. (We) just left the power plant on Lamma Island not long ago, probably within 5 to 10 minutes.

19. D: Right.

20. C: Because the journey is just like the (one) I usually have

for work.

21. D: Right. What the matter is?

22. C: Probably (a) vessel collision. The vessel is taking in water.

23. D: Vessel collision, the vessel is taking in water, right?

24. C: Right. I am at the stern now. I am trapped. I cannot get out.

25. D: *ER*, you ...

26. C: I, my daughter is trapped. The Lamma IV vessel of our company.

27. D: Vessel Lamma IV.

28. C: Right. Water is coming in ... water is coming in.

29. D: Understand. Miss, I now send ... get vehicles, get vessels to help you.

30. C: Help!

31. D: Okay, could you leave the information to the police. I get vessels to go over to help you.

32. C: Okay!

33. D: Okay.

34. C: Oh no......

35. A: Mr. LAW, could you please calm down.
